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- ★ Don't Underestimate the Importance Of Modeling
- ★ Think Of Yourself As A Mirror, Reflecting What's Going On
- ★ Great Facilitators Give People Permission To Do What They Will Do Anyway
- ★ As A Facilitator It's Good Discipline To Feel Responsible For Everything, But Participants Must Take Responsibility For Their Own Learning
- ★ Great Facilitators Understand How Privilege & Oppression Operate and Work to Minimize Their Impact in the Training.
- **★** Remember That Your Needs Are Secondary (But Not Unimportant)
- **★** Don't Let Yourself Become Defensive
- **★** Admit Your Mistakes When Appropriate
- \* Assess Your Strengths And Weaknesses & Integrate Them Into Your Design
- **★** Do Your Homework (Especially Around Volatile Issues)
- ★ Let The Participants Do The Work (Know When To Push)
- **★** Look For Opportunities For Learning Everywhere
- **★** Never Underestimate The Importance Of Meeting Basic Human Needs
- **★** Respect What The Participants Have To Offer
- **★** Be Present (Listen With More Than Your Ears)
- **★** Maintain Flexibility & Demonstrate Your Desire To Meet Their Needs
- **★** Be Aware Of The Whole Group
- **★** Don't Forget That People Learn In Different Ways
- **★** Respect Participants' Time
- ★ If You Don't Understand Someone's ?, Ask. Don't Assume Its Not Important
- **★** Imagine The Questions Ahead Of Time
- ★ Don't Forget To Let People Go To The Bathroom!
- **★** Remember That People Generally Enjoy Talking About Themselves
- **★** Think About How You Will Be Presenting Yourself
- ★ Look Forward To Making Mistakes & Learning From Them
